



ANIMAL BOARDING ESTABLISHMENTS ACT 1963

LICENCE TO KEEP AN ANIMAL BOARDING ESTABLISHMENT

THE SCOTTISH BORDERS COUNCIL, in virtue of the powers conferred upon them by the ANIMAL BOARDING ESTABLISHMENTS ACT 1963, hereby grant to **Vivian Swart**, a licence authorising them to keep a home boarding establishment for animals at **6 Upper Nisbet Cottages, Jedburgh, TD8 6TS** subject to the following conditions:

1. The number of animals accommodated at the establishment at any one time shall not exceed **5 dogs** including own pets.
2. Accommodation provided for animals must, in all respects, be suitable as regards construction, size of quarters, exercising facilities, temperature, lighting, ventilation and cleanliness.
3. All animals accommodated at the premises must be provided with suitable bedding material, and must be given adequate exercise.
4. Suitable food and drink must be provided for all animals.
5. Whilst animals are boarded at the establishment, there must always be someone resident at the premises, and all animals must be visited at suitable intervals.
6. All reasonable precautions should be taken to prevent and control the spread among animals of infectious or contagious diseases, including the provision of adequate isolation facilities.
7. All heating appliances must be of such construction as to constitute no risk of fire.
8. Appropriate steps must be taken for the protection of animals in case of fire or other emergency.
9. All bulk supplies of food must be kept in rat-proof containers.
10. A register must be kept containing a description of any animals received into the establishment, date of arrival and departure, and the name and address of the owner, such register to be available for inspection at all times by an Officer of the local authority, veterinary surgeon or veterinary practitioner authorised under Section 2(1) of the Animal Boarding Establishments Act, 1963.
11. The Licensee shall permit any Officer of the local authority, veterinary surgeon or veterinary practitioner authorised by them, to enter the premises at all reasonable times and inspect the premises and any animals found thereon or anything found therein.
12. All reasonable precautions shall be taken to prevent illegal access to or escape of the animals.
13. Washing and lavatory facilities must be available for staff.
14. A copy of this licence must be suitably displayed to the public in a prominent position in the boarding establishment.
